Student Uniform: Windsor Mill MS is a uniform school. Please review our uniform policy below:

6th Grade - Red Polos 7th Grade - Navy Polos 8th Grade - Light Gray Polos

Pants, shorts, and skirts must be khaki, black, or navy blue

- Each top should be a solid, plain polo style 3-button shirt. Shirts may not be form fitting or made of lycra.
- Students have the option to wear long or short sleeve polo shirts. They also have the option to wear a long sleeve shirt of any color **UNDER** their short sleeve polo shirts.
- Denim jeans, jeggings, leggings, pants with rips or shreds, sweatpants, and/or workout pants are **NOT** allowed.
- Gray and/or black jeans are NOT allowed.
- Students must wear closed toe shoes with a back, fully covering their heels. Tennis shoes are preferred. Slide-on-Crocs, sandals, opened toed-shoes, flip-flops, bedroom slippers, athletic slides, and shower shoes are NOT allowed.
